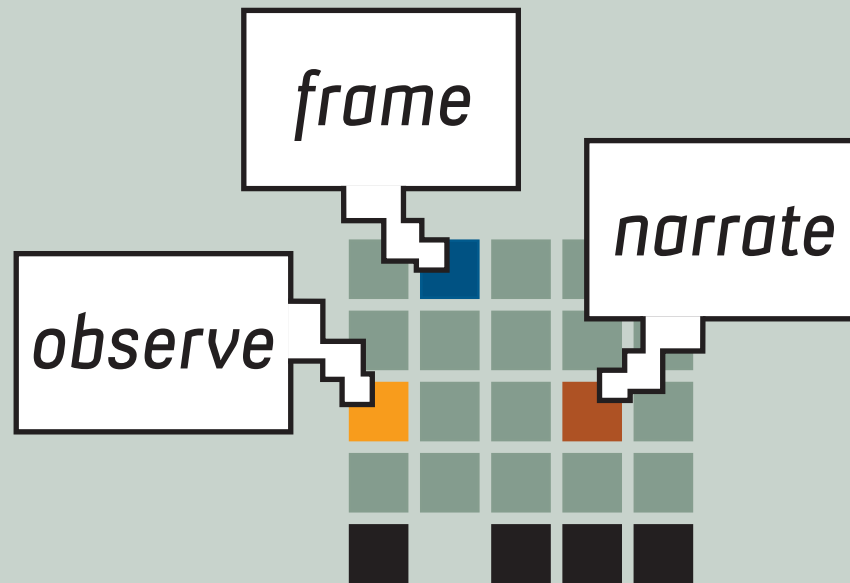


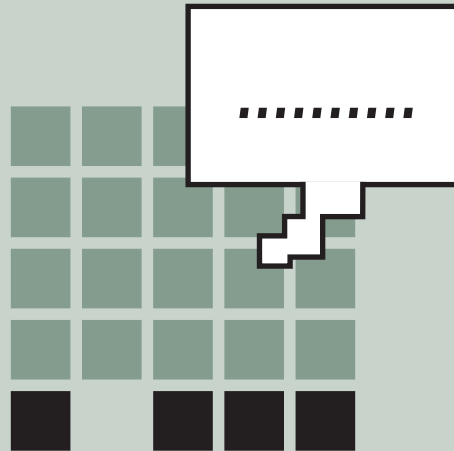
The talking buildings challenge

Give a voice to a building in 5 steps



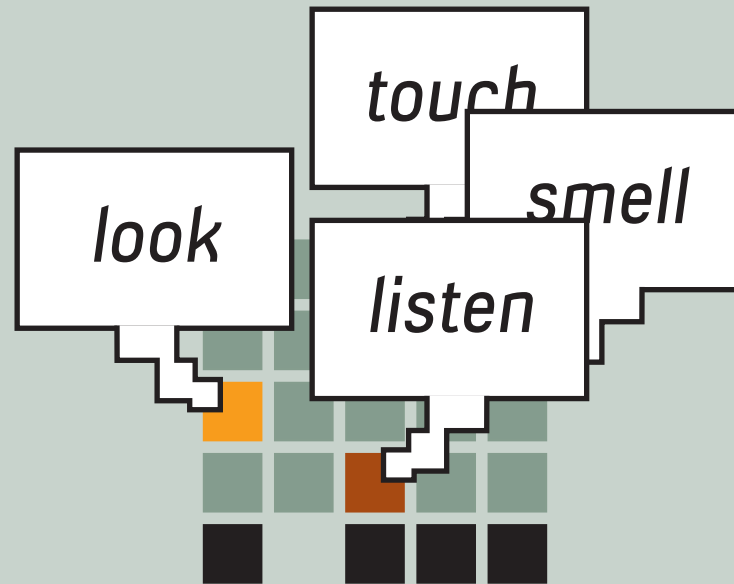
What should I do?

1. Visit a cultural heritage building you feel connected to

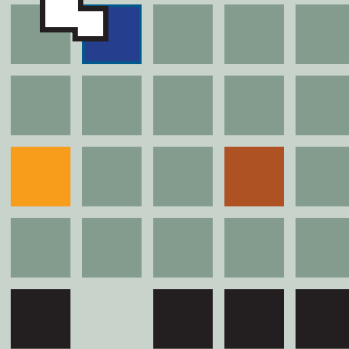
